2 02-01-2024 The present MJC- contempt petition is filed for non compliance of the order dated 28.12.2021 passed in CWJC No. 20611 of 2021.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner on instruction submitted that certain grievance of the petitioner is stated to have been complied with certain conditions and further



petitioner is also entitled to some more grievances to be redressed and the same has not been redressed. Having regard to the orders of this Court dated 28.12.2021 passed in CWJC No. 20611 of 2021 to the extent of consideration of the petitioner's representation and it has been considered. If the petitioner is not satisfied with the compliance order he is permitted to agitate whichever portion of the grievance has not been redressed as on today before appropriate forum.

3. With the above observations, the present proceeding of MJC- contempt petition stands dropped.
