2 03-05-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“1. (i) To issue a writ of Mandamus or any other writ or writs, direction or directions, commanding upon the Respondents to remove the encroachment made by Respondent No. 7 namely Mahendra Sah over Khesra No. 726 of Khata No. 127, situated in Village- Banki Tikam, P.S. &



Anchal-Madhuban, District- East Champaran, Thana No. 31, which is a public land used for Aam Rasta for the petitioner and the villagers as well as public in general.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Madhuban, District-East Champaran at Motihari, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
