A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 447, 341, 342, 323, 324, 307, 354, 379, 427, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioners along with other co-accused persons is said to have assaulted the informant and her family members.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that



there is case and counter case between the parties. He further submits that there is no specific overt act against the petitioners. There is specific allegation against co-accused, Tauheed Khan, who assaulted the son of the informant, Hasnain Khan, and the injury was found grievous in nature. He also submits that with respect to other injured persons, injuries were found simple in nature. Petitioners have one criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Laukaha P.S. Case No.188 of 2023, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
