- 3 19-01-2024 1. Heard learned counsel for the parties concerned.
2. The present petition has been filed for restoration of a criminal revision bearing Cr.Rev. no. 1016 of 2017, which has stood dismissed on account of non prosecution vide order dated 29.08.2023.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that due to illness of his father, he had gone to his native village on 27.08.2023 and therefore, he could not attend the case on 29.08.2023, hence, a sympathetic view may be taken and the aforesaid criminal revision be restored to its original file.
