seeking the following relief:-

"1.(i) Issuance of a writ of certiorari or writs in the nature thereof or any other appropriate writs/orders/directions for quashing of order dated 24/09/2022 passed in second appeal no. 42011- 21127 by Respondent No. 4.



(ii) Issuance of a writ of mandamus or writs in the nature thereof or any other appropriate writ/order/directions for cancelling the license having no. 89/2016 of Respondent No. 6 [old license no. 116/2007], subsequent to his conviction in Nima Chandpur P.S. Case No. 52/07 (S.T no. 71/2009), as per the mandate of law."
