“1. That this is an application for issuance of writ or writs in the nature of certiorari quashing the letter no- 237/2022-23 dated 03-09-22 which has been issued by the Assistant General Manager cum Disciplinary Authority, Sate Bank of India, Head Office, Patna by which the petitioner has been show cause for gross negligence to perform his duty without any basis and as it is fit to be set aside.”
