2 19-07-2024 The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing C.W.J.C. No. 17447 of 2015, which has stood dismissed for non-prosecution by an order dated 15.09.2023.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the earlier counsel for the petitioner had fallen ill suddenly and therefore, he could not attend the hearing of the case, when the



case was called out for hearing on 15.09.2023, leading to dismissal of the aforesaid writ petition for non-prosecution, thus, a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid petition be restored to its original file.
