2 02-04-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief(s):-

*“1. That this writ petition is being filed for
setting aside the order contained in memo
no.834 dated 19-08-2023 by which services of
the petitioner from the post of contractual
Revenue Karmchari has been removed without
providing/affording him any opportunity of
hearing in gross violation of principles of
natural justice and further for a direction upon
respondent authorities to allow the petitioner to
continue on the post along with entire monetary
benefits. And further for a direction to make
payment of salary for the period during which*



the petitioner has discharged duty with effect from 01-01-2023 to 18-08-2023.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent-authorities for redressal of his subsisting grievances, if any. Liberty so sought is granted.
