"1. For issuance of a writ preferably in the nature of Mandamus, Commanding and directing the Respondents concerned to remove the encroachment made over the Government Land by some persons near the road leading to Mehi Ashram inasmuch as despite the order of the Sub-divisional Officer and the Circle officer, encroached land has not been vacated by the local residents."
