2 09-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this writ application is being filed for seeking direction of this Hon'ble Court to the respondents to grant benefit of 2nd ACP/MACP pay scale of the petitioner of PB-2+5400/- in place of pay scale of PB-2+4600/- alongwith other consequential benefit, while he completed his service more than 28 years as Assistant-cum-Clerk (3rd grade) in Civil



Court, Jehanabad and it is further stated that other similar employees or Junior Employees to the petitioner have already been got such aforesaid benefit much earlier, just after issuing letters of Law Department, Government of Bihar of their respective Civil Court/Judiciary of Bihar."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the District & Sessions Judge, Civil Court, Jehanabad for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed off.
