for the informant and learned APP for the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Mahila P.S. Case No.41 of 2020 dated 26.06.2020, registered for
the offence punishable u/s 323, 341, 379, 498A, 504 and 506/34
of the IPC and ¾ of D.P. Act, pending in the Court of learned
Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Samastipur.
