seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this petition is directed for issuance of an appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/ directions for setting aside the order dated 6.4.2005 passed by learned District Magistrate, Siwan vide Arms Order No. 1960 whereby and whereunder the License of petitioner bearing Rifle License No. 127/2004 has been cancelled and also the order dated 23.12.2022 in Arms Appeal No. 79/2022 passed by learned



Commissioner, Saran at Chapra has dismissed the appeal and confirmed the order passed by the learned District Magistrate, Siwan and further directed to the respondent authorities after setting aside both orders respondent be directed to restored the License of the petitioner i.e. Rifle Licence No. 127/2004.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the liberty already granted to the petitioner to file fresh appeal, vide order dated 23.12.2022, passed by the Commissioner, Saran Division, Saran in Arms Appeal Case No. 79 of 2022, the petitioner be permitted to file a fresh appeal.
