At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to challenge the order dated 03.09.2024, passed by the District Magistrate, Patna, whereby and whereunder, the application of the petitioner for grant of arms license has been rejected, by filing appropriate appeal under Section 18 of the Arms Act, 1959.
