ORAL ORDER

2 20-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"1. That the present writ application is being filed for issuance of Writ in the nature of Mandamus, commanding the Respondent authorities, especially the Respondents No. 4 and 5 to forthwith allow the petitioners to work as Data Entry Operators, in view of the fact



that now it is not necessary for the Data Entry Operators, working with the Health Society to get themselves registered with the aforesaid Private Company for disbursement of salary, rather the Health Department is directly sending funds to the respective Health Societies for making payment of salaries to the operator. The Petitioners in alternative pray for a direction upon the respondent no. 4 to decide the detail representation of the petitioners dated 05.08.2023 sent through speed post."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the respondent authorities for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
