seeking the following relief:-

*“1.That this writ application has been
filed by the petitioner for issuance of
an appropriate writ order/ direction
commanding Respondent authorities
to maintain law and order situation
and also to provide security to the life*



and property of the petitioner and his family members i.e. the property appertaining to Khata no. 401, plot no. 1282, situated at Mauza-Korji, P.S. Phulwari, District-Patna and to restrain the private Respondents from interfering with the peaceful possession of the petitioner and from making any forceful construction over the said land.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of approaching the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna for redressal of the aforesaid grievance. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
