3 05-01-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the informant and learned APP for the State.

Petitioner has renewed his prayer for grant of regular bail which was earlier rejected by this Court vide order dated 3.4.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 51722 of 2022.

In compliance of order dt. 10.11.2023, a report with regard to the present stage of trial has been received and kept at Flag 'A'.

The report of learned Addl. District & Sessions Judge-V, Siwan dt. 25.11.2023 suggests that trial is likely to be concluded within six months.

In that view of the matter, this application stands disposed off.

The learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial



within a period of six months positively, failing which, the petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail.
