2 07-08-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

"1. That the instant writ application is being filed on behalf of the petitioner named above to seek indulgence of this Hon'ble Court for issuance of an appropriate order/orders, direction/directions or writ/writs commanding and directing the respondents concerned to remove the illegal encroachment made by



the private respondent (Respondent No. 10) over a Public land, which contains public paeen (water passage), situated at Mauza Dalluchak, Tauzi No.8176, Thana No.287, appertaining to plot no.122, Khesra No.512, Rakwa 0/46 decimal and also direct the respondents concerned to consider representation of the petitioner pending before them and pass a reasoned and a speaking order."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Belchhi, District-Patna for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
