ORAL ORDER

2 21-08-2024 Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner has preferred an appeal before the respondent no. 3 and the same is numbered as Appeal No. 413 of 2023. Learned counsel has stated that the Divisional Commissioner may be directed to dispose of the appeal filed by the petitioner as expeditiously as possible.
