ORAL ORDER

5 24-06-2024 Earlier, vide order dated 21.03.2024, the matter was referred to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of Patna High Court for exploring the possibility of amicable settlement, but the dispute between the parties could not be resolved through the process of mediation and as such, mediation failed (Report at flag 'M').

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for informant / opposite party no. 2.

3. The petitioner who is husband of informant /opposite party no. 2, apprehends his arrest in a complaint case punishable for the offences under Sections 494, 498(A) of the



Indian Penal Code and Section 3 / 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

4. Petitioner is alleged to have committed torture and harassment to opposite party no. 2 for dowry.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner offers and undertakes that he is ready to give maintenance amount of Rs. 3,000/- per month, starting from this month, to opposite party no. 2.

6. In view of the undertaking of learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is ready to give maintenance amount of **Rs. 3,000/- (three thousand) per month** to the opposite party no. 2, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the above-named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. - 3rd, East Champaran, Motihari / concerned court in connection with Kalyanpur P.S. Case No. 236 of 2023, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as on the following conditions:-

“(1) Opposite party no. 2 would file an affidavit before the court below and bring on record her savings bank account number for its



communication to the petitioner.

- (2) Petitioner would deposit the aforesaid maintenance amount per month in the savings bank account of the opposite party no. 2.
- (3) In case, the petitioner fails to deposit the maintenance amount for two consecutive months, the court below would be at liberty to cancel the bail-bond.
- (4) The aforementioned payment will be subject to any order passed in matrimonial, maintenance or connected proceedings. The present order, in no way, will preclude the parties to resolve the issue otherwise.”
