following relief(s):-

*“1(A) To quash the order contained in
memo No.102 dated 04.09.2023, issued
by the District Magistrate Lakhisarai
whereby and here under the Arms licence
of the petitioner bearing N.P Bore
Licence No.01/2023 has been cancelled
with immediate effect.*

*(B) To direct the respondents to stay the
operation of the order dated 04.09.2023
