2 20-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1(A). For issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents concerned to appoint the petitioner on any Group-C post on compassionate ground of the death of his father who died in harness in any Army Service Core Training Centre or any other similar Group-C post.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however,
