2 14-05-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*"1. That this is an application for
issuance of a writ in the nature of
Mandamus directing and commanding
the respondents to provide the
certified copy of sale deed bearing No.
7074 executed by vendor Raja Sen
dated 21.05.1990 in favour of vendee
(petitioner) before the Registrar of
Assurance 5 No Govt. place (N) 1st
floor, Kolkata- 700001 with regard to
the land situated in District-East*



Champaran (Bihar) to the petitioner as the petitioner is lady aged about 50 years tried her level best by making contact to the office of Registrar Insurance, Kolkata but the C.C. of the said sale deed was not provided. And/or pass such other order/orders as may appear just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
