“1. That the present writ petition is being filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the official respondents to remove the encroachment from public land bearing Khata No.162, Plot No.1358, situated



at Mauza-Banuchhapar, Thana No.129, P.S. Banuchhapar, District-West Champaran, which has been encroached by the respondents no.5 to 9, by constructing hut and also by keeping construction materials.”
