2 22-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief:-

“1. That this application is being filed for
issuance of appropriate writ/writs, order/orders,
direction/directions with regard to quashing of



the Order dated 21.08.2023, passed in Anganwari Revision Case No. 121/2022 by Respondent Commissioner, Saharsa, whereby and whereunder the Respondent Commissioner has dismissed the application of the petitioner as not maintainable. The petitioner further prays for quashing of the order dated 03.08.2022, passed in Anganwari Appeal No. 06/2020 by Respondent District Magistrate, Saharsa, whereby and whereunder the Appeal filed by the petitioner has been dismissed. The petitioner further prays for quashing of the order dated 03.01.2020 passed in Anganwari Appeal Case No. 107/2019-20, by Respondent District Program Officer, Saharsa, whereby and whereunder Appeal filed by the petitioner has been dismissed. The petitioner further prays for selection on the post of Anganwari Sevika, for Anganwari Centre- Panchbighi, Centre No. 257, situated at Ward No. 06, Sitanabad North Panchayat Block Simari Bakhtiyarpur, District Saharsa.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law including that of filing a suit before the learned Civil Court



having competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
