2 11-11-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable u/s 191(2), 329(3), 126(2), 352, 115(2), 118, 109, 303(2) of the B.N.S. Act, 2023.

3. Allegedly, all accused persons including the petitioners came to the informant and started abusing and assaulting the informant and his family members with lathi, danda and knife due to which the informant and his family members got badly injured.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence.



They have been falsely implicated in this case. There is general and omnibus allegation against petitioner nos. 1, 2, 3 and 5. Although there is specific allegation against the petitioner no. 4 that he stabbed knife in the stomach of informant's brother Sandeep Kumar but as per injury report of Sandeep Kumar which is annexed as Annexure 3 of the bail application, the injury was found to be simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. There is case and counter case between the parties. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and nature of injury, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Uchakagaon P.S. Case No.240 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023.
