2 23-10-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1(i). To issue an appropriate writ / writs order/orders, direction/directions in the nature of mandamus for punishing the Government officials as well as the private respondents for



engaging in embezzlement & misappropriation of the Government’s fund to the tune of Rs. 5,69,38,448=00 and conduct an enquiry through the competent authority.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands dismissed.
