ORAL ORDER

3 22-01-2024 Heard learned counsels for the parties.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 504, 506, 354, 498(A) and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. Vide order dated 17.03.2023, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Center of the Patna High Court to amicably resolve the dispute between the parties. The learned Mediator has submitted its report dated 16.05.2023 in which it is clearly stated that the dispute between the parties has been resolved and the terms of settlement mutually agreed upon by them is being attached with this report.

4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the



event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Aurangabad Mahila Case No. 02 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
