ORAL ORDER

2 17-05-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That by the present application, the petitioner invoking extra ordinary jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court, prays for issuance of writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to hold enquiry regarding the family list given by the respondent no. 4 in which she has stated the name of 4 children of the petitioner as children of the respondent no. 4 and obtained all the



benefit P.F., Gratuity, Life Insurance, Pension etc. after death of her husband namely Late Bishundeo Chaudhary, who died during the service of postman at Postal Department, Anchal-Khaira, District-Jamui."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
