2 12-11-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned A.P.P.

for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 25 (1-b)a, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. Three boys were sitting in Barpura Ghachi and after seeing the police force they tried to escape but one of them, namely, Ranjan Kumar was caught from whom a local country made pistol was recovered from his left waist. The detained person disclosed the name of the petitioners as his fleeing accomplices.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that no such occurrence as alleged ever took place. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case on the basis of confessional statement of apprehended accused Ranjan Kumar, which has no



evidentiary value in the eye of law. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of eight weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Sonapur P.S. Case No.586 of 2024, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
7. The court below is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioners as stated in paragraph no.3 of the bail application. If any other case is pending against the petitioners as what has been stated in paragraph no.3, this order will loose its force automatically.
