2 14-11-2024 The limited prayer made by the petitioner in the present writ petition is to direct the Divisional Commissioner, Darbhanga Division, Darbhanga, i.e. the respondent no.2 to dispose off the appeal, filed by him, bearing Appeal No.05 of 2023.

2. *Per contra*, the learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case the aforesaid appeal is still pending consideration, the same would definitely be disposed off, within a fixed time frame, as is fixed by this Court.
