ORAL ORDER

2 20-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*"1. That the present writ application is
being filed for issuance of Writ in the
nature of Certiorari or any other
appropriate Writ, Order, direction,
quashing the Memo No. 1192 dated
25.08.2021 (Annexure P/2), issued by
the Respondent No.5, whereby a*



general direction has been issued to the Data Operators, appointed under Rogi Kalyan Samiti to make their claim before the Urmila Private International, for consideration of their appointment, through the said agency, failing which it shall be construed that the seat of the said Data Operators stands vacated and requisition will be sent for appointment to the concerned agency. The Petitioner further prays for consequential writ of Mandamus, commanding the Respondent authorities, especially the Respondents No. 4 and 5 to forthwith allow the Petitioner to work as Data Entry Operators, in view of the fact that now it is not necessary for the Data Entry Operators, working with the Health Society to get themselves registered with the aforesaid Private Company for disbursement of salary, rather the Health Department is directly sending funds to the respective Health Societies for making payment of salaries to the operator. The Petitioner in alternative prays for a direction upon the respondent no. 4 to decide the detail representation of the petitioner dated 10.08.2023 sent through speed post."

2. After some arguments, the learned



counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
