ORAL ORDER

4 13-11-2024 It is stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has preferred a revision before the Divisional Commissioner, Darbhanga against the orders of the appellate authority as well as the orders of the Sub Divisional Officer cancelling the license of the petitioner and learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that though the revision has been filed in the year 2020, the same has not yet been disposed of till date.
