- 2 07-05-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1. That this Writ application is being filed on behalf of the petitioner for direction upon the Respondents to pay the compensation for the damage of the house and property to the petitioner in the flood in the August 2017 under the scheme of the State Government.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a civil suit before the learned Civil Court having
