ORAL ORDER

2 23-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this is an application for a writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding and directing to the respondents to pay to fix the pay scale to the petitioner of Rs. 5000-8000 in the light of memo no. 2525 dated 20.4.2006 and memo no. 2185 dated 27.4.2006 (Annexure-1), issued under the signature of Deputy Secretary, Finance Department, Govt. of Bihar, Patna because petitioner has been superannuated from the service on



31st October, 1997 as the then was Co-operative Extension Officer, functioning under the Respondent no. 4 (B.D.O. Sadar Block, Patna)."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
