The present MJC is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 01.04.2022 passed in CWJC No. 12517 of 2021. In the light of order dated 01.04.2022 petitioner submitted appeal before the Secretary on 06.05.2022, thereafter, the matter was referred to the District Magistrate and in turned District Magistrate referred to Sub-divisional Officer. The Sub-



divisional Officer proceeded to consider the grievance of the petitioner and proceeded to pass order on 07.01.2023 and the same has been placed on record along with the show cause on behalf of the Opposite Party No. 7 along with Annexures- A and B.
