2 07-05-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1. That this is an application for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus or any appropriate writ, order, direction to the respondents concerned to take action against the Revenue Karamchari (R- 6) and Circle Officer (R-4) who have illegally issued rent receipt in the name of Lalita Devi (R-6) regarding Khata No. 815, Khesra No. 3934 area 6.54 dec. after creation of Zamabandi.

(ii) Further for issuance of a direction to the
