APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Beldaur  
P.S. Case No. 279 of 2024 instituted for the offences under  
Sections 25(1-B)A, 25(1-AA), 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per prosecution case, there is a direct and  
specific allegation against the petitioner of carrying huge  
number of ammunition. The police has recovered altogether 220  
live cartridges of .315 bore from the pillion driver of the  
motorcycle which was being driven by the petitioner. The police  
has also recovered one mobile from the possession of the  
petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence as alleged  
against him and has falsely been implicated in the present case.



He further submits that no fire-arms has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the seized arms. There is a non-compliance of Section 100 of the Cr.P.C. which creates a serious doubt in the prosecution case. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent and is languishing in judicial custody since 31.07.2024 without any rhymes or reason.

5. On the other hand, learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Having heard rival contention of both the parties and considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case as also taking into account the period of custody of the petitioner and the petitioner having no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, abovenamed, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Beldaur P.S. Case No. 279 of 2024.
