2 22-02-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief:-

“1(i). That the instant writ application is being
filed for directing the respondents to appoint the
petitioner on the post of the Constable Home
Guard/any suitable post on compassionate ground
as Late Banaras Singh constable no.10640 (father
of the petitioner) died in harness while he was
discharging duty at Civil line P.S. Gaya on the
strength of command certificate dated 4.10.2011
issued by the office of Commandant, Home
Guard, Gaya.”



2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Respondents authorities for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
