2 11-11-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Sadar
P.S. Case No. 605 of 2022 instituted for the offences under
Sections 414, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that, police, on the
basis of secret information apprehended one co-accused person
namely Mohan Kumar Yadav and one stolen motorcycle was
recovered.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case.
Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner was not



apprehended on the spot rather his name has transpired in this case on the basis of disclosure made by the apprehended co-accused Mohan Kumar Yadav. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner has got no concern with the recovered motorcycle. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 23.08.2024 and has two criminal antecedents.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as also the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 605 of 2022, subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two



consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the
bail bonds of the petitioner.
