ORAL ORDER

2 22-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

"1. a) To quash the Selection Letter dated 28.05.2018 issued by the Respondent No. 6 whereby and whereunder the Respondent No. 8 was illegally appointed as Anganwadi Sevika of Gram Panchayat Raj



Pakadiya Harsidhi, Ward No. 2 a most mechanical and arbitrary manner without following the procedure prescribed under the relevant Guidelines.

b) For a direction upon the Respondents to appoint / select the Petitioner on the post of Anganwadi Sevika of Gram Panchayat Raj Pakadiya Harsidhi, Ward No. 2 along with all consequential and monetary benefits.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks a direction upon the District Programme Officer (I.C.D.S.), District-East Champaran to dispose off the pending complaint filed by the petitioner bearing Anganwadi Case No. 102 of 2019.

3. The learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case the aforesaid complaint is still pending, the same shall definitely be disposed off within a fixed time frame.

4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to direct the District Programme Officer (ICDS), District-East Champaran to dispose off the



aforesaid complaint, in case the same is still pending, by passing a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks' from today.

5. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
