APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under section 366A, 504, and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per FIR, the informant alleged that the petitioner and co-accused persons abducted her daughter due to ulterior motives.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this present case merely on the basis of suspicion. As per statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 of the



Cr.P.C., wherein she has stated that she was well acquainted with this petitioner and she went to Bangalore with him with her own sweet will. It is further submitted that the victim has not stated about any wrong doings against the petitioner and the medical report has also not supported the prosecution version. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Moreover, he is languishing in judicial custody since 10.08.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer of Bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as judicial custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Bhabhua P.S. Case No. 464 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-III, Kaimur at Bhabhua.
