ORAL ORDER

2 29-10-2024 At the outset, learned Advocate for the petitioner seeks permission to make the District Judge-cum-Chairman, Legal Services Authority, Bihar Sharif, Nalanda as party respondent no. 3.

2. Permission is accorded.

3. The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court seeking a direction upon the respondents concerned to ensure the compliance of the Memo No. 15/Bihar Sharif, dated 24.05.2022 issued by the Office of District and Sessions Judge, Nalanda (Bihar Sharif) whereby, the petitioner was duly appointed in E-Seva Kendra, on monthly honorarium of Rs. 15,000/-. Despite having worked for a year together, the



petitioner has not been allowed the remuneration for the entire period.

4. Mr. Piyush Lall, learned Advocate for the respondent fairly contended that if the respondent has any grievance with regard to the non-payment of remuneration, the petitioner may approach before the newly added respondent no. 3.

5. In that view of the matter, the writ petition stands disposed off with a liberty to the petitioner to approach before the respondent no. 3 by filling an appropriate representation.

6. In case such a representation is filed preferably within a period of four weeks from today, the respondent no. 3 shall consider and dispose off the same.

7. In case any remuneration of the petitioner is found due, the same shall be paid expeditiously within a further period of four weeks.
