learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with

Maner P.S. Case No. 620 of 2024 instituted for the offences

under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise

(Amendment) Act, 2018.

3. As per prosecution case, the police has recovered

total 769.44 litre of illicit liquor from the motorcycle, tempo,

car as well as godown of Ram Pravesh Rai.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that

the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence as

alleged against him and has falsely been implicated in the



present case due to highhandedness of police officials. He further submits that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is neither driver nor the owner of any vehicles as also no any liquor has been recovered from his conscious possession. The petitioner has no concern with the seized liquor or the alleged vehicles. There is a non-compliance of Section 103 of the B.N.S.S. which creates a serious doubt in the prosecution case. The petitioner has two criminal antecedents and is languishing in judicial custody since 12.09.2024 without any rhymes or reason.

5. On the other hand, learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Having heard rival contention of both the parties and considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case as also taking into account the period of custody of the petitioner, let the petitioner, abovenamed, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction
