seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this writ application is being filed for giving order/ orders or direction/ directions commanding the respondents to initiate a proceeding under Section 3 of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956 against the Respondent no. 5 namely, Gonu Mandar, who has encroached the Aam Rasta of Khata No. 4861, Khesra 17887, area 10 dhur situated in village Habidih, P.S. and Anchal Baheri, District-Darbhangha.”
