- 3 05-03-2024 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the informant.
2. The petitioner apprehends her arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 365 of the Indian Penal Code.

No. 3536 of 2024 and the concerned Superintendent of Police shall ensure that the Investigating Officer of the case strictly adheres to the direction contained in the said order dated 13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No. 3536 of 2024.
