seeking the following relief:-

" That, this writ application is being



filed for issuance of writ in the nature of writ of mandamus, directing the respondents authority to pay the arrears of difference salary from 1.01.2006 to 31.03.2010 by way of revised Pay Scale with effect from 1.1.2006 any arrear of difference salary by way of A.C.P. effect from 1999 as well as arrears of difference, Dearness allowance from 1.1.2005 to till date along with interest to the petitioners."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the Commissioner, Patna Municipal Corporation, Patna for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. It is needless to state that in case appropriate representation is filed, within a period of two weeks from today, the Commissioner, Patna Municipal Corporation, Patna shall dispose off the same by passing a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of six



weeks, thereafter.

4. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
