2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

3. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in

connection with Motipur P.S Case No. 125 of 2022 dated

04.04.2022 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 363,

366A read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

4. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and

the co-accused persons are alleged to have kidnapped the

minor daughter of the informant by enticing her.



5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. There was love affair between the petitioner and the victim. The victim in her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. has stated that she has solemnized marriage with the petitioner with her sweet will and has been spending her happy conjugal life. The learned counsel further submitted that the victim was not forced to have illicit intercourse with another person. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned, Muzaffarpur in connection with Motipur P.S Case No. 125 of 2022, subject to conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code



of Criminal Procedure.

8. The application stands allowed.
