Heard the parties.

2. This petition has been filed for the following reliefs:-

“1. That, this is an application for issuance of appropriate writ (s), direction (s) for commanding the respondents to issue the license for running the saw mill of the petitioner, namely, Azad Timber Works, Gurwaliya, Bettiah, Police Station-Manuapool O.P., District-West Champaran, which is in the name of petitioner and include the name of saw mill of the petitioner, namely, Azad Timber Works, Gurwaliya,



Bettiah, Police Station-Manuapool O.P., District-West Champaran in the seniority list of the District, which is running since 1992, and the petitioner has already applied for renewal of his license of saw mill in the year 1993 and deposited fee of Rs.1000/- for issuance of license for running saw mill, but the same has not been issued for which the petitioner has no fault.

AND/OR

For passing such other order or orders for which the petitioner will be found entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it will suffice if he is allowed to approach the respondent no.1, the Principal Secretary, Environment and Forest Department, Government of Bihar, Patna for redressal of his grievance in view of the fact that to his knowledge, the State Government is taking certain decisions for granting new licenses.

4. Granting said liberty and without making any comment on the merit of the case, the writ petition stands disposed of.
