2 11-12-2024 Heard learned counsels for the parties.

2. The petitioners apprehends their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2)/3(5) of the B.N.S. 2023.

3. As per the FIR, the allegation against the petitioner is that he assaulted the informant and his father and brother.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The



allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is an admitted land dispute between the parties. It is further submitted that the injuries are of simple nature. Earlier the learned Court below had rejected the bail application of the petitioners only on the ground that the injuries were found on the vital part of body. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Lakhuara P.S. Case No.80 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023.
