3 15-01-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned A.P.P appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody in a
case registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of killing the daughter of the
informant for non-fulfillment of dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that petitioner is innocent and she has falsely
been implicated in this case. The petitioner is sister-in-
law of the deceased and she had no concern with the
day-do-day affairs of the deceased and her husband. The



petitioner if 50 percent physically handicapped and unable to move anywhere freely. The petitioner is languishing in custody since 08.04.2023.

In contra, learned A.P.P appearing on behalf of the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the period under custody, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Katihar in connection with Kadwa P.S. Case No. 52 of 2023.
